CSSL Annual General Meeting (AGM) 2024



The Computer Society of Sri Lanka held its 35th Annual General Meeting on January 17, 2024, at the Shangri-La Hotel in Colombo. During this significant event, the reelection of Dr. Ajantha Atukorale as President for the year 2024 was confirmed, and the new executive council for the year was appointed.

Dr. Atukorale, who currently serves as the Director at the Colombo University School of Computing (UCSC), brings a wealth of experience and expertise to his role. He earned his B.Sc. Honours Degree with first-class honors in Computer Science from Colombo University in 1995 and obtained his Ph.D. in Neural Pattern Recognition from the University of Queensland, Australia, in 2002. Renowned in the Sri Lankan IT community, Dr. Atukorale has built a distinguished career in academia and society.

A member of CSSL since 2006, Dr. Atukorale has been on the CSSL Executive Council since 2013. He has played a crucial role in numerous CSSL initiatives, including the Seoul Accord Degree Accreditation Program, CSSL Awards, NSSC, NITC, and the CSSL Research Colloquium. Additionally, he represents CSSL on the University Grants Commission's Standing Committee on Computing and the Standing Committee on Technology.

In his acceptance speech, Dr. Atukorale outlined his vision and planned actions for 2024, emphasizing CSSL's commitment to advancing professionalism in computing in Sri Lanka. Key initiatives for 2024 include:

- Tech Talks and Workshops: Offering opportunities for computing professionals to stay updated on the latest trends and technologies.
- Special Interest Groups (SIGs): Facilitating collaboration and knowledge-sharing among professionals with common interests.
- Expansion of GenZ Chapter Activities: Engaging young people in the computing sector to nurture future tech talent.

- National Schools Software Competition (NSSC): Encouraging innovation and creativity among school students.
- National IT Conference (NITC): Providing a platform for computing professionals to network and share expertise.
- Incorporating CSSL with an Act of Parliament: Enhancing CSSL's legal standing to play a more effective role in Sri Lanka's computing sector development.

Dr. Atukorale expressed gratitude to the outgoing Executive Council members Mr. Damith Hettihewa, Commodore Janaka Gunaseela, Dr. Thilina Halloluwa, and Dr. Parakum Pathirana by presenting them with tokens of appreciation for their valuable contributions.

The reelection of Dr. Atukorale and the appointment of the new executive council mark a new chapter for CSSL. With a clear vision and a strong team, CSSL is poised to lead the development of the computing sector in Sri Lanka.

CSSL Strengthens the IT Skills of Grama Niladari in Puttalam District

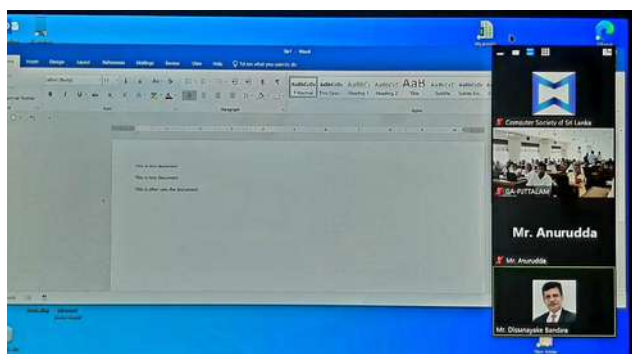

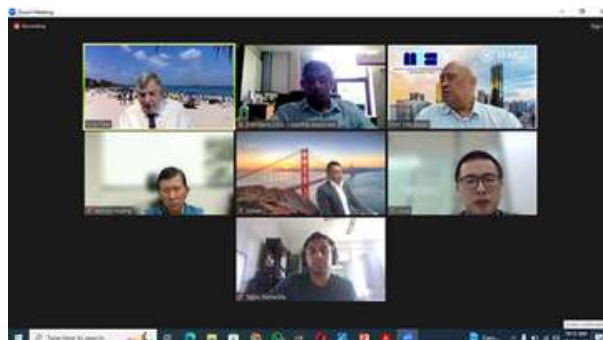
Dr. Ajantha Atukorale Represents CSSL at Seoul Accord Mid-term 2024 Meeting in New Delhi

In 2022, CSSL has invited reputable business leaders to define the characteristics of a CIO for this worthy initiative. The eminent panel consisted of veteran banker Mr. Rajendra Thiagarajah, SLCERT Chairman Mr. Rohan Muttiah, Deutsche Bank Head of Operations Mr. Prabath Wickramaratne, Lanka Bell Managing Director Dr. Prasad Samarasinghe, ESOFIT Chairman Dr. Dayan Rajapaksha, University of Colombo School of Computing (UCSC) Director and CSSL President Dr. Ajantha Atukorale, Nimbus Cloud Lanka Managing Director and CSSL Immediate Past President/Project Chair of CSSL National CIO List Mr. Damith Hettihewa.

This group of top intellectuals deliberated extensively and came up with a list of 12 characteristics to evaluate the top CIOs in the country. CSSL CIO Model which comprises 12 elements namely Strategic IT Acumen, Transformation Management, Business Mindset, Digital Advocate, Operational Excellence, Performance Orientation, Financial Discipline, Risk Management, Talent Management, Leadership and Professional Excellence, Global Exposure, Legal Compliance will serve as the foundation framework for selecting the top CIOs in the country. This model will also be evaluated against industry practices and evolve further while tracking industry dynamics. As a result, this will be kept on the CSSL agenda.

Having been established in 1976, the CSSL is the apex body for ICT Professionals and the longest standing ICT association in the country. The CSSL is a member of the South-East Asia Regional Computer Confederation (SEARCC), International Federation for Information Processing (IFIP) and provisional signatory to the Seoul Accord, an internationally acclaimed degree accreditation program through which CSSL brings international standards on ICT related degrees to Sri Lanka. CSSL became the First Association in South East Asian region to be accredited by Internationals Professional Practice Partnership (IP3).



CSSL Participated at IFIP General Assembly in Slovakia

IFIP General Assembly was chaired by IFIP President and Former Australian Computer Society President Mr. Anthony Wong , IFIP General Secretary Professor, Dr. Anatolii Marushchak , IP3 (International Professional Practice Partnership) Chair Moira De Roche and other ICT Professional body leaders from all parts of the world.

IFIP GA 2023 was hosted by Slovak Society for Computer Science and held at Falkensteiner Hotel in Bratislava on 19th and 20th September 2023. The Chief Guest State Secretary of MIRRI Slovakia Mr. Martin Bezek and delegates were welcomed by Chairman, Slovak Society for Computer Science Mr. Branislav Rován.

IFIP GA 2023 agenda included IFIP Strategy formation for 2024, IFIP Task Force on Digital Education report , IFIP Task Force on Climate Change and Digital Technology Report, IP3 Accreditations, AI for Good and several other key strategic global ICT policy interventions were deliberated over two days and way forward was decided. David O'Leary Award was also announced at IFIP 2023.

International Federation for Information Processing (<https://ifip.org/>) is the global umbrella body of ICT professional bodies around the world. CSSL is an IFIP member since its early days. IFIP represents ICT professional societies from over 40 countries or regions, covering all 5 continents with a total membership of over half a million. IFIP is recognized by United Nations and other world bodies, has a formal consultative partnership relations with UNESCO, ITU and ECOSOC, links more than 6000 scientists from Academia and Industry, organized in more than 101 Working Groups reporting to 13 technical committees. IFIP GA 2024 is scheduled to be held in September 2024 in Lisbon Portugal.
